

Folded Star



Stamp Set: Teeny Tiny Wishes

Ink: Basic Gray

Paper: Basic Gray, Strawberry Slush, Smoky Slate, Confetti Celebrations Designer Series Paper

Accessories: Big Shot, Circles and Bitty Banners Framelits, Stylish Stripes Embossing folder, Candy Dots

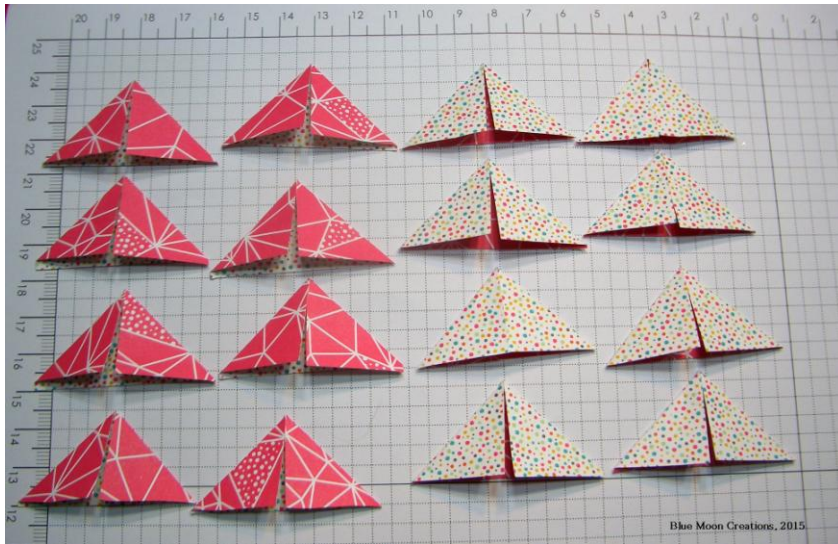
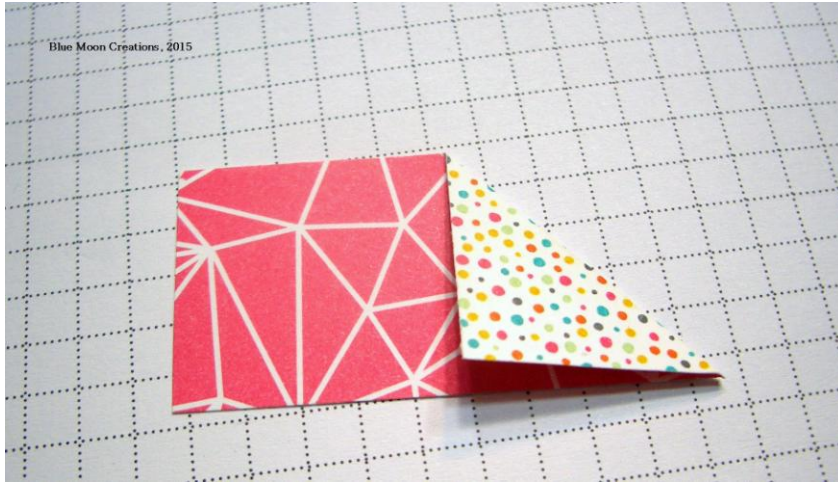
You will need 16 rectangles cut out of Designer Series Paper. Use the double-sided DSP and use 1 sheet for both designs of the star. Or use 2 different sheets of DSP to mix and match the design.

The size of the rectangles we are using for this project measure 1" x 2". But, they could be any size. Just make sure that the height is half of the width. The smaller the rectangles, the smaller the star. The larger the rectangles, the bigger the star.



1. Cut 16 rectangles of paper. These measure 1" x 2".

2. Fold the corners down on the rectangles, forming a triangle. Use a bone folder to crease the score lines.



You want to have 8 of one design, and 8 of the other design.



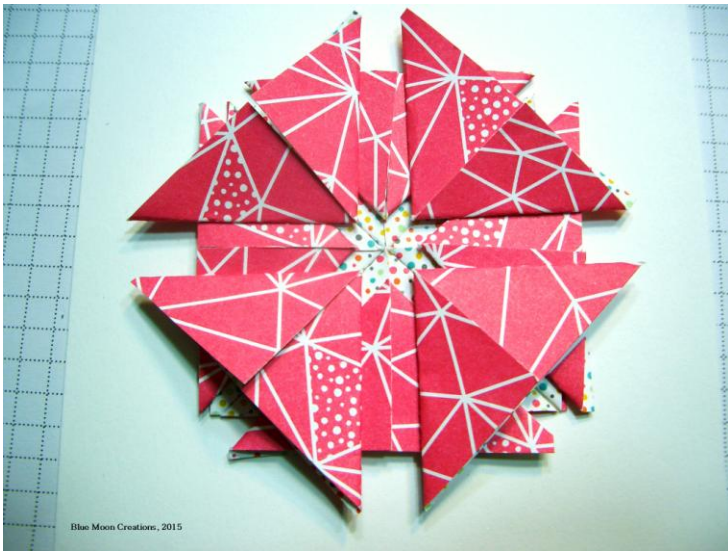
2. Cut a square piece of card stock to use as your card base. This piece is what you will build your star on. Our piece measures $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " and is cut out of Whisper White card stock.

3. Mark the center of your card base using a pencil. Arrange 4 of the triangles, meeting the points at the marked center.

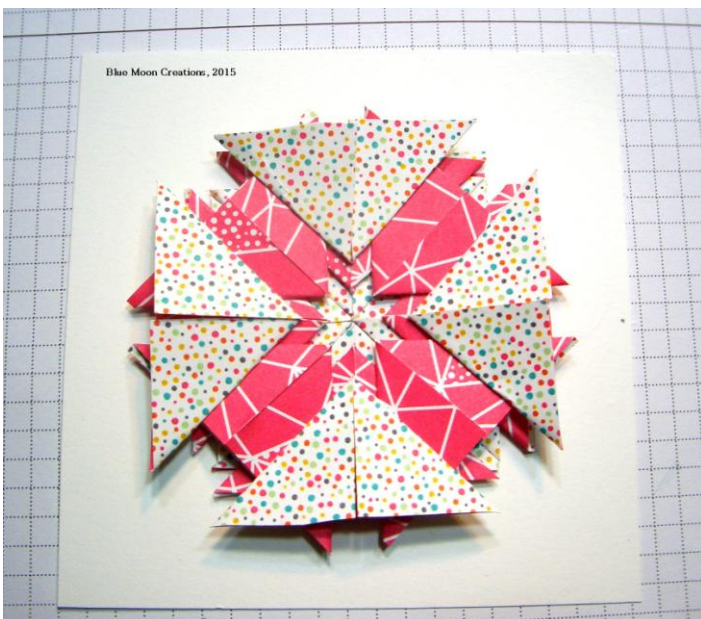
Adhere them using SNAIL. Smooth the score lines on each layer using the bone folder if needed.



4. Take the opposite color and adhere 4 points over the first layer, leaving about $\frac{1}{4}$ " showing.



5. Take the 2nd color again, and layer points along the visible seam of the FIRST layer.



6. Using the last 4 triangles, layer the points up to the visible seam of the SECOND layer of points. This is your finished star!



Now to complete the look:

7. Cut a square piece of Smoky Slate card stock measuring $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ ". Using the Big Shot and Circles Framelits, cut a circle out of the middle.

8. Run the piece through the Big Shot and Stylish Stripes Embossing Folder.

9. If desired, trim down the Whisper White base on the Folded Star. Place Smoky Slate cover over the Folded Star, securing with SNAIL adhesive

TIP: There is bulk to the Folded Star, and the Smoky Slate top may pop up. Instead of using SNAIL, use Dimensionals to intentionally pop it up!

10. Cut a ring out of a piece of Smoky Slate card stock using the Big Shot and 2 Circles Framelits. Place the ring over the star to finish off the look.

11. Layer the Smoky Slate to Strawberry Slush card front using Dimensionals. Layer to Basic Gray card base.

12. Stamp greeting from Teeny Tiny Wishes using Basic Gray ink on scrap piece of Strawberry Slush card stock. Cut out using the Big Shot and Bitty Banners Framelits. Attach to front of card.

13. Add a neutral Candy Dot to the center of the star.
