

Peaceful Cabin Stair Step Card

Supplies Used:


Stamp Sets: Peaceful Cabin, Mountain Air, Tidings and Trimmings

Ink: Basic Gray, Basic Black, Evening Evergreen, Sahara Sand


Paper: Smoky Slate, Basic White, Champagne Foil

Accessories: Simply Scored Scoring Tool, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Cabin and Majestic Mountain Dies,

Stamparatus, 1" circle punch, clear block "F", bone folder, Adhesive Foam Strips



1. Cut card base measuring 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5". Score at 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 8", and 9  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".




2. Fold along the score lines to create the stair step. Use a bone folder to get crisp score lines.



3. Now stamp and cut pieces for the design.


I stamped the cabin from Peaceful Cabin on a piece of Basic White card stock using Basic Gray ink.



Cut out using die-cut machine and coordinating Cabin Die.




Stamp trees from Peaceful cabin on Basic White card stock using Evening Evergreen ink.



Cut out using a die-cut machine and coordinating Cabin Die.



Stamp mountains from Mountain Air on Basic White card stock using Basic Gray ink.




Cut out using die-cut machine and coordinating Majestic Mountain Die.

Cut another mountain out of Champagne Foil Paper.




Stamp trees from Mountain Air on Basic White card stock using Sahara Sand ink.



Cut out using die-cut machine and coordinating Majestic Mountain Die.



Stamp moon from Majestic Mountain using Basic Gray ink. Cut out using 1" circle punch.




4. Create background for back panel.

Tap Smoky Slate, Basic Gray and Basic Black ink onto clear block "F". Spritz with water and stamp on Basic White card stock measuring 5" x 4 1/4".

Let the block sit for a few seconds, then lift. Set piece aside to dry.



Attach to Evening Evergreen mat.



5. Now to build the back panel.

Layer mountains and trees using Foam Adhesive Strips in between.





Attach the moon to the background piece.

Apply a strip of Foam Adhesive to the back of the mountain and tree piece,



and attach to the background piece.

Trim the side edges with a pair of scissors if needed.


Apply adhesive to the bottom 2/3 only of the background. You want the top to be free and extend above the score line.



6. Now to decorate the first panel.

Stamp greeting from Tidings & Trimmings on right side of first panel using Basic Black ink.


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Attach strips of Foam Adhesive to the back of the cabin,



and attach to the first panel.



7. Finally, decorate the middle panel.

Layer trees together using strips of Foam Adhesive.

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Attach to middle panel, trimming the edges with a pair of scissors if needed.
