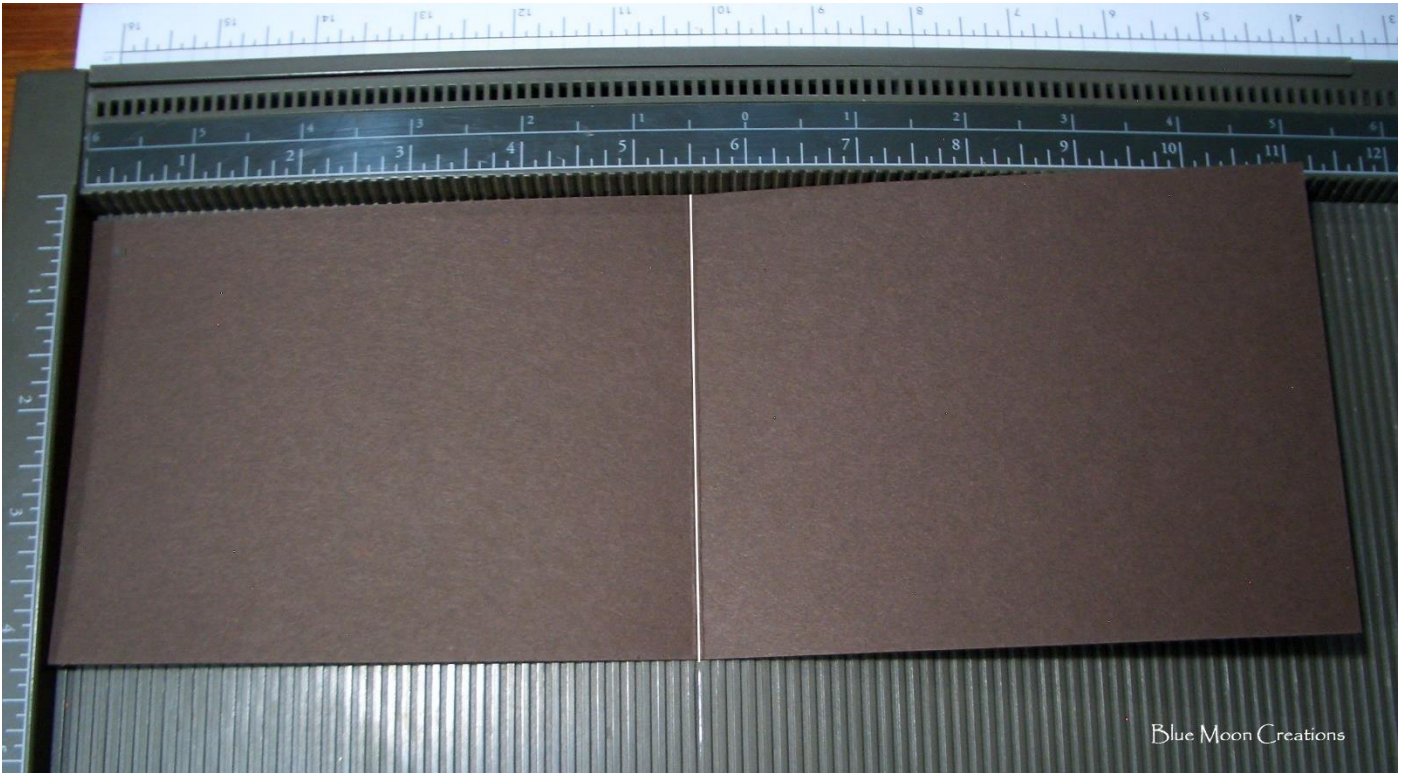


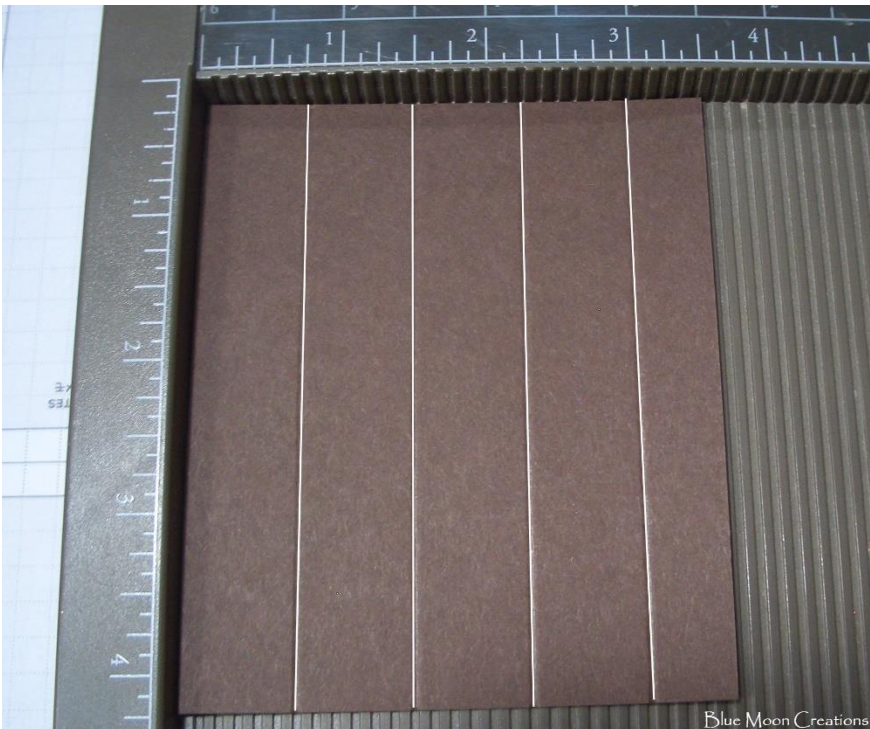
Easy Pop-Up Card

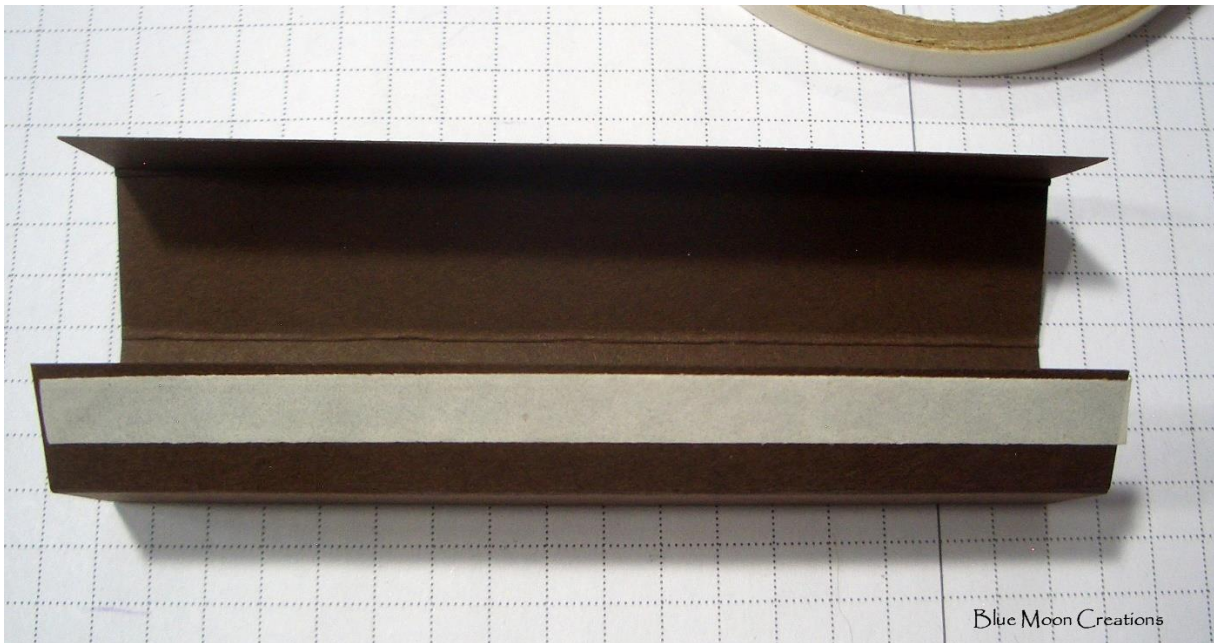


1. Create base and mechanism for the pop-up card:

-Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2"

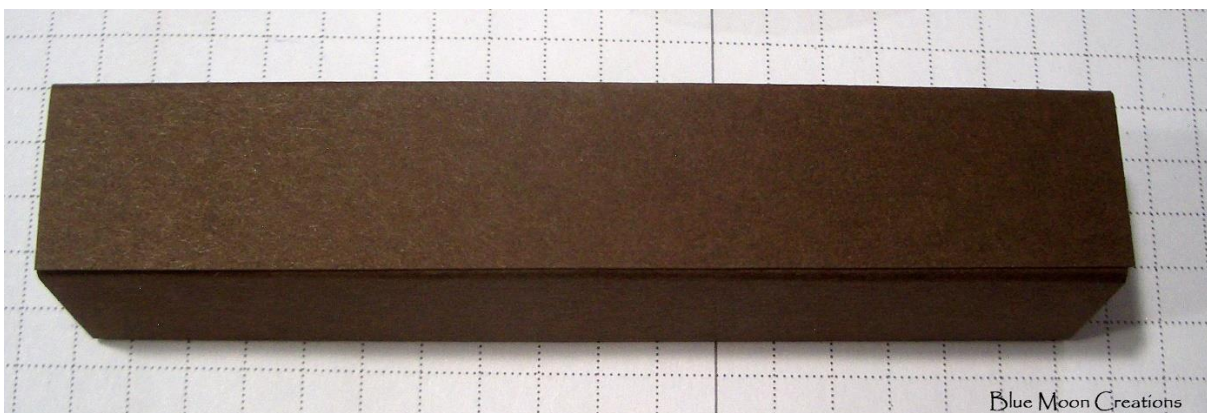


2. Pop-up mechanism: 4 1/4" x 3 1/2",
scored vertically at 3/4", 1 1/2", 2 1/4", and
3".



3. Fold along score lines using a bone folder to get crisp score lines.

4. Attach a strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the narrow panel.



5. Remove backing on Tear & Tape Adhesive. Fold top panel to secure, creating the pop-up mechanism.



6. Attach strips of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the back and bottom of the pop-up mechanism. You want the side with the seam to face the back.

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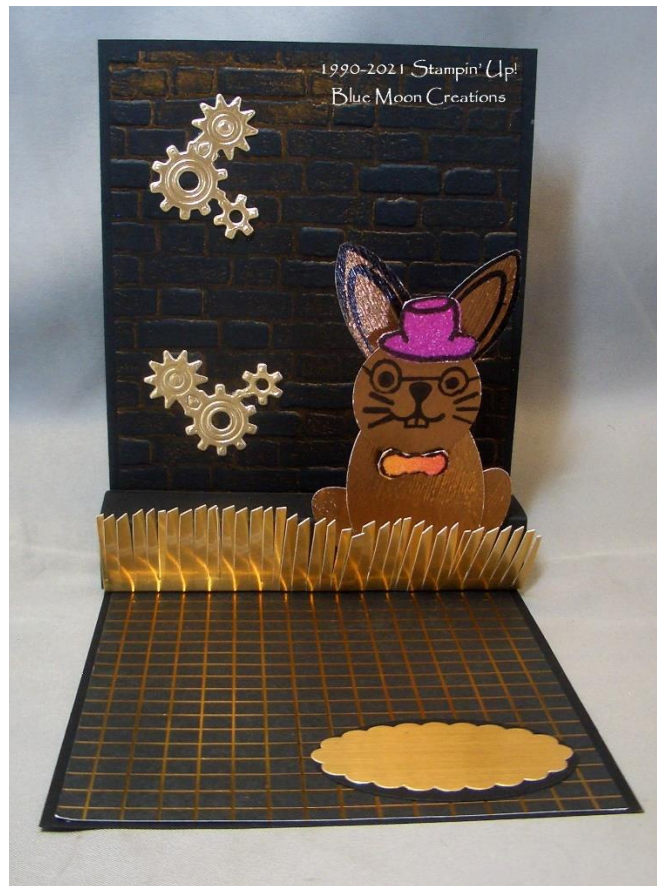


7. Remove the backing on the Tear & Tape on the bottom of the pop-up mechanism. Place it on the bottom of the base, up against the score line of the card.

8. Remove the backing on the Tear & Tape on the side of the pop-up mechanism. Fold the card closed, attaching the pop-up mechanism to the inside of the card.

TIP:

I found it easier to decorate the front and inside panels of the card before attaching the pop-up mechanism. You won't have the bulk or the fold of the card to work around, making placement and alignment more difficult. Once the card has been decorated, you can attach the pop-up mechanism and then add your decorations and embellishments to it to complete.

Supplies Used:

Stamp Sets: Playful Pals, Bunny Buddies

Ink: Black Stazon, Gold Metallic, black Sharpie pen

Paper: Basic Black, Brushed Metallic, Rainbow Glimmer, World of Good Designer Series Paper

Accessories: Simply Scored Scoring tool, bone folder, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Subtle and Brick & Mortar Embossing Folders, Garage Gears and Oval Dies, circle and oval punches, fringe scissors, Tear & Tape Adhesive, Tombow Glue, Mini Dimensionals

1. Create base and mechanism for the pop-up card:

-Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2"

-Pop-up mechanism: 4 1/4" x 3 1/2", scored vertically at 3/4", 1 1/2", 2 1/4", and 3". Attach a strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the narrow panel. Remove backing on adhesive, fold top panel to secure, creating the pop-up mechanism. Apply strips of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the bottom and inside side of the mechanism. Set to the side for now.

2. Decorate the front and insides of the card before attaching the pop-up mechanism.

Front:

-Cut gears out of Brushed Metallic DSP using a die-cut machine and Garage Gears die.

-Cut emblem out of Basic Black card stock using a die-cut machine and Garage Gears Die.

-Cut another emblem out of Brushed Metallic DSP. Stamp greeting from Bunny Buddies using Black Stazon ink.

-Cut or punch oval out of Rainbow Glimmer Paper.

-Attach black and gold design from World of Good DSP to the front of the card base. Attach gears using Tombow Multi-

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Purpose or Fine Tip Glue. Attach oval. Attach emblem. Attach greeting inside the emblem using a Dimensional to pop it up.

3. For the inside:

- Swipe gold metallic ink on the inside of the Brick & Mortar embossing folder. Insert a piece of Basic Black card stock and emboss. Attach to the top inside panel.

- Attach another piece of black and gold paper from World of Good DSP to the bottom inside panel.

- Punch or cut scallops out of Basic Black and Brushed Metallic DSP. Layer and attach to the bottom. This will be where you write your greeting using a fine tip Sharpie.

4. To create the bunny:

- Punch circle and oval pieces for the head, ears, body, and legs out of Brushed Metallic DSP.

- Stamp face images from Bunny Buddies and Playful Pals stamp sets on circle piece using Black Stazon ink.

These two sets are retired. If you don't have a stamp set with face images, you can draw the face on the circle using a marker or Sharpie pen. If you don't feel comfortable drawing, turn the bunny around, so you see its backside (see Steam Punk Easter Card video for details).

- Emboss the body parts using a die-cut machine and Subtle Embossing Folder.

- I decided my Steam Punk bunny needed a top hat and bow tie. I drew the top hat and bow tie on the backside of a scrap piece of Rainbow Glimmer Paper using a pencil. I fussy cut them and then drew the outline/detail using a black Sharpie pen. I attached them to the bunny using Dimensionals to pop them up.

5. Create grass:

- Cut a piece of Brushed Metallic DSP measuring 4 1/4" x 1 3/4" and scored at 3/4". Cut the blades of grass using a pair of fringe scissors. Or use regular scissors to snip the blades.

6. Fold the grass along the score line and attach it to the bottom of the pop-up mechanism by removing the backing on the Tear & Tape Adhesive. Place another strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the bottom of the grass. Remove the backing and place the mechanism below the card base score line.

Remove the Tear & Tape backing on the side of the mechanism. Fold the card closed, adhering the piece to the card base.

7. Place Dimensionals on the bottom part of the bunny and attach to the pop-up mechanism. TIP: You don't want to apply any adhesive above the mechanism as it will interfere with the card's opening and closing.

8. Attach more gears to the embossed Brick & Mortar background to complete.



Flowers for Every Season Pop-Up Easter Card front and inside

Supplies Used:

Stamp Sets: Bunny Buddies, Butterfly Gala, Dry Brush, A Good Day

Ink: Memento Black, Magenta Madness, Bermuda Bay, Cinnamon Cider, Misty Moonlight, Balmy Blue

Various Stampin' Blends

Paper: Blushing Bride, Magenta Madness, Soft Sea Foam Whisper/Basic White, Flowers for Every Season 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper

Accessories: Simply Scored Scoring Tool, bone folder, Butterfly Duet Punch, various circle and oval punches, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Subtle Embossing folder, fringe scissors, Tear & Tape Adhesive, Mini Dimensionals

1. Create base and mechanism for the pop-up card:

-Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2"

-Pop-up mechanism: 4 1/4" x 3 1/2", scored vertically at 3/4", 1 1/2", 2 1/4", and 3". Attach a strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the narrow panel. Remove backing on adhesive, fold top panel to secure, creating the pop-up mechanism. Apply strips of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the bottom and inside side of the mechanism. Set to the side for now.

2. Decorate the front and insides of the card before attaching the pop-up mechanism:

Cut three panels of Flowers for Every Season 6"x6" Designer Series paper measuring 1 1/4" x 5 1/4". Attach to Blushing Bride card base.

3. Stamp greeting from A Good Day using Magenta Madness ink on Soft Sea Foam card stock. Punch using 1 1/4" circle punch or die. Attach to 2" circle Blushing Bride mat using a Dimensional to pop it up. Attach to Magenta Madness 2 1/4" circle or sunburst circle mat. Attach to the card base using Dimensionals to pop it up.

4. For the inside:

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- Stamp Dry Brush background stamp on Whisper/Basic White card stock by tapping color from ink pads directly to the stamp. I used the Stamparatus and cleaned the stamp in between colors. The first color applied was Misty Moonlight, then Balmy Blue. Attach to the top inside panel.
- Attach a striped piece of Flowers for Every Season DSP to the bottom inside panel. Punch 2" circle out of Blushing Bride card stock. Attach to Magenta Madness 2 1/4" circle or sunburst circle mat. Attach to the bottom of the card. Use this to write your greeting.
- 5. To create the bunny:
 - Punch circle and oval pieces for the head, body, and legs out of Magenta Madness card stock. Stamp ears from Bunny Buddies on a scrap piece of Magenta Madness card stock using Memento Black ink. Cut out using a pair of scissors.
 - Stamp face images from Bunny Buddies stamp set on circle piece using Memento Black ink.This set is retired. If you don't have a stamp set with face images, you can draw the face on the circle using a marker or Sharpie pen. If you don't feel comfortable drawing, turn the bunny around so you see its backside (see Steam Punk Easter Card video for details).
- Emboss the body parts using a die-cut machine and Subtle Embossing Folder.
- 6. Create grass:
 - Cut a piece of Soft Sea Foam card stock measuring 4 1/4" x 1 3/4" and scored at 3/4". Cut the blades of grass using a pair of fringe scissors. Or use regular scissors to snip the blades.
- 7. Fold the grass along the score line and attach it to the bottom of the pop-up mechanism by removing the backing on the Tear & Tape Adhesive. Place another strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the bottom of the grass. Remove the backing and place the mechanism below the card base score line.
- 8. Remove the Tear & Tape backing on the side of the mechanism. Fold the card closed, adhering the piece to the card base.
- 9. Place Dimensionals on the bottom part of the bunny and attach to the pop-up mechanism. TIP: You don't want to apply any adhesive above the mechanism as it will interfere with the card's opening and closing.
- 10. Stamp butterflies from Butterfly Gala on a scrap piece of Whisper/Basic White card stock using Magenta Madness ink. Color using a variety of Stampin' Blends or Stampin' Write Markers. Punch using the coordinating Butterfly Duet punch. Attach to the Dry Brush background using Dimensionals to pop them up.
- 11. Stamp Easter eggs from Bunny Buddies or similar using Bermuda Bay, Magenta Madness, and Cinnamon Cider inks. Fussy cut using a pair of scissors. Attach to the grass using Dimensionals to pop them up.
- 12. Fussy cut a bow out of Flowers for Every Season DSP and attach it to the bunny using a Dimensional to pop it up to complete.



Jar of Flowers Pop-Up Easter Card front and inside

Supplies Used:

Stamp Sets: Jar of Flowers, Butterfly Gala, Bunny Buddies

Ink: Magenta Madness, Misty Moonlight, Blushing Bride, various Stampin' Blends

Paper: Soft Sea Foam, Misty Moonlight, Magenta Madness, Whisper/Basic White, Just Jade, Flowers for Every Season 6"x6" Designer Series Paper

Accessories: Simply Scored Scoring Tool, 2 1/2" and 2 1/4" circle punches, Butterfly Duet Punch, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Subtle and Brick & Mortar Embossing Folders, fringe scissors, Tear & Tape Adhesive, Mini Dimensionals, Glue Dots, sponge

1. Create base and mechanism for the pop-up card:

-Card Base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 5 1/2"

-Pop-up mechanism: 4 1/4" x 3 1/2", scored vertically at 3/4", 1 1/2", 2 1/4", and 3". Attach a strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the narrow panel. Remove backing on adhesive, fold top panel to secure, creating the pop-up mechanism. Apply strips of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the bottom and inside side of the mechanism. Set to the side for now.

2. Decorate the front and insides of the card before attaching the pop-up mechanism:

-Punch 2 1/4" circle out of Flowers for Every Season DSP. Mat to Misty Moonlight 2 1/2" circle.

-Cut a strip of Magenta Madness card stock measuring 1" x 4". Emboss using die-cut machine and Subtle Embossing Folder.

-Attach piece of Flowers for Every Season DSP to the card base. Attach Magenta Madness strip. Attach circle using Dimensionals to pop it up.

-Stamp greeting from Bunny Buddies or similar on Whisper/Basic White card stock using Magenta Madness ink. Lightly sponge Blushing Bride ink. Attach to Misty Moonlight mat. Attach to card front using Dimensionals to pop it up.

3. For the Inside:

-Swipe Soft Sea Foam ink directly from the pad on the inside of Brick & Mortar embossing folder. Insert Whisper/Basic White card stock and emboss. Attach to the inside top panel.

-Attach Just Jade card stock to inside bottom panel. Cut strip of Magenta Madness card stock measuring 1" x 4".

Emboss using die-cut machine and Subtle embossing folder. Attach to Just Jade panel.

-Stamp butterflies from Butterfly Gala using Misty Moonlight ink. Color with Stampin' Blends or Stampin' Write markers. Punch using Butterfly Duet punch. Attach to top and bottom panels using Glue Dots or Dimensionals.

4. For the pop-up mechanism:

-Stamp 3 flower images from Jar of Flowers on Whisper/Basic White card stock using Misty Moonlight ink. Color using a variety of Stampin' Blends or Stampin' Write Markers. Fussy cut using a pair of scissors.

-For the grass, cut a piece of Soft Sea Foam card stock measuring 4 1/4" x 1 3/4", scored at 3/4". Cut the blades of grass using a pair of fringe scissors. Or use regular scissors to snip the blades.

5. Fold the grass along the score line and attach it to the bottom of the pop-up mechanism by removing the backing on the Tear & Tape Adhesive. Place another strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive along the bottom of the grass. Remove the backing and place the mechanism below the card base score line.

6. Remove the Tear & Tape backing on the side of the mechanism. Fold the card closed, adhering the piece to the card base.

7. Place Dimensionals on the bottom part of the flower images and attach to the pop-up mechanism to complete. TIP: You don't want to apply any adhesive above the mechanism as it will interfere with the card's opening and closing.
